LESSON QUIZZES

- The first attempt is the attempt averaged into the course grades.
- Users may attempt a lesson as many times as they choose.
- Users may see all of the answers and solutions notes upon submission of first attempt.
- All attempts are individually reviewable
- Logout of the system, due to inactivity, is set at 45 minutes
- When logged out or choosing to log out, a return to a lesson quiz remembers all work times or dates before fully completing and submitting, without fear of losing work completed - meaning, a user may begin a lesson or lessons and return to them at later
